A PIT Count is designed to track the level of homelessness in a community. The goal of this count is to gain a clear picture of the trends in homelessness in Saskatoon, in conjunction with other counts happening across Canada. Individuals and families who are homeless on the street, in shelters, in inappropriate accommodations and those who are at-risk of imminent homelessness will be counted on a single day: **Wednesday April 18, 2018.**
