CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Excellence in Planning Award

The purpose of this award is to recognize the best in professional planning work undertaken by members in communities and regions across Saskatchewan:

1. Research and New Directions in Planning
2. Excellence in Policy Planning
3. Excellence in Planning Practice (Urban and Rural)

Eligibility

1. An individual or project team, provided at least one member of the project team is a member of SPPI in good standing and played a substantial role in the project
2. The submission must represent a completed plan, design, policy or research study
3. The project must have started during the preceding two years and have been:
 - a) Sanctioned by a board, council, planning department, educational institution, or firm, but not necessarily formally adopted by resolution, bylaw, or other legislation; or
 - b) implemented through physical construction; or
 - c) Published by a recognized publisher or public agency.

he person/team must be nominated by two RPP members in good standing. Deadline for submissions is August 12, 2022

Nomination Process

Nominations must include the following:

- ◆ A letter (no more than 2 pages) that describes the name of project or initiative, name of team or individual, and provides a short background on the project or initiative, information regarding implementation of the project, confirmation that the stakeholder is aware of and supports the submission.
- ◆ The letter must be signed by both members making the nomination/submission.
