You will be part of the Regional and Provincial Interest Unit where the priorities are to manage Saskatchewan's land use planning legislative and regulatory framework, encourage inter-community and regional cooperation between communities on land use planning matters, and provide education and training to clients on community and land use planning matters.

Reporting to the Director of Regional Planning, you will be responsible to:

- Review and prepare amendments to The Planning and Development Act, 2007, and its associated regulations;
- Build relationships with municipalities, First Nations, Métis communities, and industry to advance Saskatchewan's Growth Plan for the Next Decade of Growth 2020-2030;
- Participate in planning initiatives at the provincial, regional, and municipal levels to coordinate and align services with future population and economic growth;
- Support regional, inter-community and municipal planning efforts to address growth and development opportunities and challenges;
- Provide professional and technical advice on a variety of community and land use planning matters; and
- Develop and deliver educational resources to build regional, inter-community and municipal capacity for land use planning and service delivery.

Typically, the knowledge, skills and abilities required for this position will be obtained by the completion of a degree in rural/urban/regional planning or a related field combined with several years of planning and policy experience at a provincial, regional or municipal level.

You must be a Full or Candidate member of the Saskatchewan Professional Planners Institute (SPPI) or equivalent Provincial and Territorial Institute and Association (PTIA), or be eligible for Full or Candidate membership with SPPI or equivalent PTIA. (Salary is under review.)
