They will administer and review planning applications, conduct research and analysis of community planning issues and conduct community outreach on land use related issues. They will be required to make presentations at Council meetings and to represent the City at public meetings and Development Appeal Board hearings. The incumbent will also mentor and supervise planning staff.

- Review and act as signing authority for Development Permits.
- Mentors and provides guidance to the Planning staff.
- Provides recommendations regarding Zoning Bylaw, Official Community Plan Bylaw, and other planning-related bylaw amendments.
- Conducts research and builds reports necessary for economic, housing, and regional planning.
- Oversees Derelict properties administration and maintenance in conjunction with Building Inspection contractors, and Planner.
- Provide leadership pertaining to continuing the downtown revitalization.
- Participates in economic development projects and initiatives.
- Assists with public contact and outreach on Utility, Pavement, Replacement Projects (UPAR).
